



## **Call for Nominations for *Journal of Management & Organization* Editors**

Nominations are sought for qualified potential Editors for the *Journal of Management & Organization* (ISSN 1833-3672), the journal of the Australian and New Zealand Academy of Management (ANZAM). The person selected for the Editor and Associate Editor vacancies will serve a term of office of three years, beginning 1 March 2010.

The *Journal of Management & Organization* (JMO) is an international peer-reviewed journal listed in SSCI and ranked as a B level journal on the Australian national journal list (ERA). The outstanding achievements JMO has achieved already are in no small measure due to the outstanding contributions and quality of our Editorial Board. In keeping with JMO's mission, we are seeking nominees for the new Editor and Associate Editor roles who are scholars of the highest scholarly standing representing the various research areas and paradigms associated with the management discipline. Editors will work with the ANZAM Journals Committee in continuing to build the standing of JMO as the leading management journal in Oceania, as well as a high quality outlet for global perspectives on the full range of management research, inclusive of theoretical, empirical, qualitative, quantitative, and critical perspectives.

JMO publishes original research on areas that address the interests of management academics worldwide and welcomes submissions from cognate disciplines, including psychology, education, political science, sociology, economics, and statistics. Editorial Board members represent esteemed scholars from different regions of the world collectively providing expertise in the thematic areas of strategic management, OB, HRM, employment relations, industrial relations, labour relations, operations management, entrepreneurship, family business, religion and workplace spirituality, international business, governance and corporate social responsibility, organisation theory, critical management studies, knowledge management, public sector management, management education, and qualitative, quantitative and mixed methods.

Specific qualifications for the role of Editor and Associate Editor include the following:

- An internationally recognised record of research excellence in management.
- Extensive experience and an excellent reputation as a reviewer, an Editorial Board member, or Editor of a management-related journal.
- Demonstrated administrative skills, capacity to meet deadlines, and an ability to work constructively with members of the Editorial Board, authors, reviewers, Guest Editors, the publisher and the ANZAM executive.
- A doctoral degree in a management-related discipline.
- A commitment to join ANZAM if not already a member.
- Commitment from the nominee's university to support her or him with office space and equipment for the duration of the term of office.
- Familiarity with, and an ability to use, a web- and email-based review system.

- The Editor will be expected to attend three Executive meetings a year including the annual ANZAM conference, at which the Editor will chair a meeting of the Editorial Board.

Nominations, including self-nominations, will be accepted by email up until 19 February 2010 at the ANZAM office, and are to include:

- Nominee's name, full address, telephone numbers, and e-mail address
- A letter describing the nominee's qualifications and experience relevant to the selection criteria
- A current curriculum vitae
- A letter from the candidate's employer confirming the support noted above
