



Professor Neal M. Ashkanasy
UQ Business School, University of Queensland



Neal Ashkanasy is Professor of Management in the UQ Business School, University of Queensland. He came into academic life after an 18-year career in professional engineering and management. He has a PhD (1989) in social and organizational psychology from the University of Queensland, and has research interests in leadership, organizational culture, cross-cultural leadership, and business ethics. In recent years, however, his research has focused on the role of emotions in organizational life.

Professor Ashkanasy has published over 100 journal articles and book chapters, and is author or co-author of over 150 conference papers. His work has appeared in leading international refereed journals such as the *Academy of Management Review*, the *Academy of Management Executive*, *Accounting, Organizations and Society*, the *Journal of Management*, the *Journal of Organizational Behavior*, the *Journal of Personality and Social Psychology*, and *Organizational Behavior and Human Decision Processes*. He is co-editor of four books published by leading US-based publishers: *The Handbook of Organizational Culture and Climate* (Sage), *Emotions in the Workplace: Theory, Research, and Practice* (Quorum); *Managing Emotions in the Workplace* (ME Sharpe), and *Emotion in Organizational Behavior* (LEA); and series co-editor of *Research on Emotion in Organizations* (JAI Press/Emerald).

In addition, Professor Ashkanasy administers two e-mail discussion lists: *Orgcult-L*, the Organizational Culture Caucus list; and *Emonet-L*, the Emotions in the Workplace list, with a combined subscription membership of over 1300. Professor Ashkanasy is Editor-in-Chief for the *Journal of Organizational Behavior*, and Associate Editor of *Emotion Review*. He also sits on numerous editorial boards, including the *Academy of Management Review*, the *Journal of Applied Psychology*, and the *Journal of Management*. He has organized four *International Conferences on Emotions in Organizational Life*, and is now planning the seventh conference to be held in Montreal in August 2008.

Professor Ashkanasy is a Fellow of the Society for Industrial and Organizational Society, the Association for Psychological Science, and ANZAM. He is the 2010 ANZAM President and a Past Chair of the Managerial and Organizational Cognition Division of the Academy of Management.
