Professor Gael McDonald is the Dean of the Faculty of Business and Law at Deakin University, Melbourne, Australia. Previously, she was Vice President of Research and Professor of Business Ethics at Unitec, Auckland, New Zealand.

She has a BBS from Massey University, New Zealand, an MBA from the University of Western Australia, and her Doctorate was obtained from The London School of Economics and Political Science, England. Professor McDonald has taught undergraduate and/or graduate courses in Australia, New Zealand, Malaysia, Macau, United States and Canada in the areas of International Marketing, Human Resource Management and Organisational Behaviour. She has also published widely in academic and professional journals, and consulted in the private sector. In 2003 Gael appeared in Unlimited Magazine's selection of the 150 most powerful women in business in New Zealand.

Professor McDonald is a past President of the Australian and New Zealand Academy of Management, and has twice been a member of the New Zealand Performance Based Research Fund Panel in Business and Economics.
