Ingrid Nielsen is Professor of Management and Associate Dean (Research) in the Faculty of Business and Law at Deakin University. Prior to her current appointment, Ingrid spent 12 years at Monash, including several as Director of Research in the Department of Management and then as Associate Dean (Research and Research Training) in the Faculty of Business and Economics.

Ingrid's research interests are in labour migration; and work and life satisfaction. She has published widely on those topics in journals such as *British Journal of Industrial Relations*, *International Journal of Human Resource Management*, *Urban Studies*, *Social Indicators Research* and *Journal of Urban Affairs*. Much of her work takes a cross-cultural perspective, predominantly focussed in and on Asia.

She also holds a current ARC Discovery Grant on the role of psychological capital on the workplace integration of refugees. Ingrid has a particular interest in journal rankings and research metrics and was the Chair of the 1503 and 1599 panels within the Australian Business Deans Council's review of its journal list.

Ingrid is also well known for her passion for ECR development. She developed and led Monash's ECR Network from its inception in 2006 until her departure to Deakin in 2013. At Deakin she has now established BUiLD – the Business and Law Development Network to support the development of emerging researchers in the Deakin Business School and Deakin Law School. Ingrid is always happy to discuss new work with ECRs and to work with them where there are synergies.
