All papers submitted will be refereed using a double blind peer review process. Accepted papers will be published in the conference proceedings CD. Presenters will have 15 minute timeslots, plus 5 minutes for discussion.

WORKSHOPS – Workshops and research symposia are invited and will have 90 minute timeslots. Presenters of workshops should submit a 300 word abstract outlining the topic and relevant issues.
