Poems must be on the theme 'leadership' but we conceive this very broadly. For example, poems may be about leaders, either living, dead or fictitious. They can be written from the perspective of leader or follower. Or they may be a more abstract reflection on the process of leadership. Alternatively, they could reflect on the desire to be a leader, the leader's experience, the failure of leaders, or the need for leaders. Submissions may even question whether or not leadership exists or why we romanticize leaders. These are but a few suggestions and we welcome unique interpretations of the theme.

Poems can be in any style or convention, but the maximum length is 100 lines. They must not be previously published or under consideration elsewhere.
