

Call for Expressions of Interest – ANZAM 2012 Stream Chairs

With the 2011 ANZAM Conference in Wellington well and truly completed, the wheels are now in motion for the 2012 ANZAM Conference in Perth. A number of Stream Chair positions have become available and we are seeking suitable applicants. Ideally ANZAM would like Stream Chairs to take on the role for consecutive years so as to ensure consistency and also, where possible, to participate in the Conference itself.

Generally Stream Chairs are responsible for recruiting reviewers for the Stream, assisting in the paper review process, making final decisions on the papers accepted, recommending sequencing and clustering of papers to be presented at the Conference, selecting Best Stream Award Papers, and recommending potential Best Conference Paper winners. These activities take place under the guidance of, and in collaboration with, the Conference Chair and Promaco as the Conference organiser.

A package of materials will be made available to Stream Chairs early in February when the call for papers is made. The 'busy' times are likely to be when recruiting and appointing reviewers throughout February and March; after 30 June (submission deadline); by the time revisions need to be completed (15 August); and particularly between 15 August and 31 August, as final paper acceptances, paper sequences, clusters, and Best Paper recommendations are all due by 31 August. Closer to the conference date (from early October), some assistance with confirming final papers and the recruitment of Session Chairs is also part of the interaction.

The following Stream Chair positions are available for the 2012 Conference and beyond:

- Gender and Diversity in Organisations
- International Management
- Marketing and Communication
- Human Resource Development and Organisational Change
- Strategic Management
